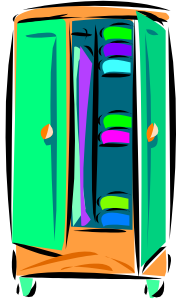

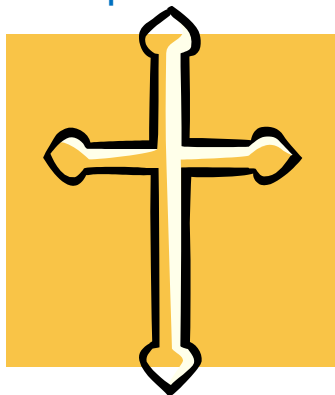
Our 39th Anniversary Celebration will take place on May 4th at Park Place Banquet Center in Dearborn. We are currently looking for donations for our Silent
